Operating from a head office in Woking and four subsidiary branches in Norton Canes, Bristol, Egham, and Langley Engineering in Reading, Jointing Technologies Ltd (JTL) are the leading distributor of specialist power cable and accessories, supplying products and services that develop, connect and maintain the UK's electrical infrastructure. In providing this market leading service, JTL are acutely aware of the environmental impacts and opportunities that are created by the organisation and have therefore implemented an Environmental Management System (EMS) within the following scope:

- Distribution of specialist power cables and accessories including cable cleats, joints and terminations for use with LV and MV cables.
- The design manufacture and assembly of cable cleats.
- The design, supply and installation of trace heating systems, including leak detection, electrical underfloor heating and ramp heating.
- The hire of specialist cutting and crimping power tools.

To ensure environmental considerations are embedded within company strategy and operations, JTL have made the following commitments:

- JTL will continue to support the infrastructure required for the UK electrical network to move towards renewable power generation.
- JTL will continually improve the EMS through the implementation and maintenance of environmental objectives, targets and associated action plans.
- JTL will reduce energy use where feasible across its estate including the installation of LED lighting to support this endeavour.
- JTL will implement all practical solutions to reduce, reuse and recycle waste materials.
- JTL will take a life cycle perspective of its operations and embed environmental considerations into the procurement process including the procurement of hybrid vehicles where feasible.
- JTL will ensure environmental protection and prevention of pollution within its scope of activities.
- JTL will ensure compliance with applicable environmental legislation and relevant compliance obligations.

To ensure the above can be achieved, JTL's Environmental Management System has been fully integrated into business processes and complies with the requirements of the international standard ISO 14001:2015.



Awareness of this policy and the relevant requirements of the EMS amongst all employees and stakeholders is crucial. To this end a programme of training and awareness is embedded within the business to ensure all key stakeholders are fully aware of required standards and expectations.
